On-board Legionella risks

Complete our training and learn about the principles of water treatment, contamination and potential hazards for crew safety. Vessels are vulnerable for contaminations due to a number of on-board conditions:

- Water temperature between 25 and 45 °C
- Stagnation (dead ends, unused tap points, etc)
- Corrosion and nutrients such as iron or zinc
- Long and complex piping networks



Why is it so important to learn about Legionella risks?

Among the many Legionella species, Legionella pneumophila is known to cause Legionellosis, a potentially fatal pneumonia for humans. Because of potential health risks associated with Legionella, the bacteria is subject to mandatory reporting, mandatory risk assessments and increasingly stringent regulations in most developed countries.
